There will be some changes to our dress code policy for the 2010-2011 school year. In order to allow you to make the necessary adjustments, we are notifying you in advance. Our main priority at Creek Wood High School is to provide and maintain an orderly environment that is conducive to learning. We are implementing the dress code to promote a more effective climate for learning, increase campus safety and security, foster school unity and pride, ensure modest dress, and minimize the cost to parents. We, as educators, believe that this will help us reach our goal to be one of the best schools in Tennessee.

The new dress code is as follows. All students are to wear a solid red, navy blue, white, or grey collared shirt. A Creek Wood High School T-shirt may be worn in place of a collared shirt. Blue jeans and khaki pants may be worn, as well as khaki shorts or skirts to the knees. Pants, shorts, or skirts will have no holes, frays or tears. No hats or sunglasses will be allowed in the building.
