<b>00</b> Dropout, under 18	00 – Dropout, under 18. Transfers to Adult HS, GED program or Job Corps should be coded as dropouts. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student remains in the cohort if there is no subsequent enrollment.
<b>01</b> Dropout, 18 and over	01 – Dropout, 18 and Over Transfers to Adult HS, GED program or Job Corps should be coded as dropouts. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student remains in the cohort if there is no subsequent enrollment.
<b>02</b> Withdrawn to state	02 – withdrawals should be limited to transfers to institutions run by Children’s Services (Listed Below) Use W6 if the student is transferred to a Non-Public School on our list. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student is removed from the cohort.
<b>03</b> Transferred to other Tennessee school system	03 – Transferred to other Tennessee school system. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student remains in the cohort if there is no subsequent enrollment.
<b>04</b> Transferred to other school in same system	04 – Transferred to other school in same system. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student remains in the cohort if there is no subsequent enrollment.
<b>05</b> Transferred out of state	05 – Transferred out of state. Proof that a student actually enrolled is required. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student is removed from the cohort.
<b>06</b> Transferred to non-public school in Tennessee	06 – Transferred to any Tennessee non-public school contained on the state list. Proof that the student actually enrolled is required. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student is removed from the cohort.
<b>07</b> Doctor certified withdrawal	07 – Doctor certified permanent withdrawal. This code should be used only for students who are so sick or incapacitated (in the opinion of a physician licensed by the State Board of Medical Examiners) that no return to school is anticipated and the withdrawal is considered permanent. Students with a temporary medical condition should be kept enrolled and treated as Homebound students. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student is removed from the cohort starting school year 2010-11
<b>08</b> Deceased	08 – Deceased (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student is removed from the cohort.

<b>11</b> Court Order	11 – Court Order, or other government mandated placement. This should be used only in cases in which a court forbids a student from attending school. Copy of court order or judge’s decision must be on file. (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student remains in the cohort if there is no subsequent enrollment.
<b>12</b> Graduation prior to spring	12 – Graduation prior to spring graduation. If student graduates at time of withdrawal district must report a completion document type.  Special Education students who return to school after receiving a Special ed Completion document should be withdrawn with a W12 when they leave. It is not necessary to report a completion document type (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student remains in the cohort if there is no subsequent enrollment.
<b>13</b> Permanent dismissal from Tennessee’s voluntary pre-k program.	13 – Permanent dismissal from Tennessee’s voluntary pre-k program. The program provider must provide to the State a written request and justification for permanent dismissal of any child from the pre-k program. No child is to be permanently dismissed without consultation between and agreement of the grantee and the Tennessee Department of Education. (Rev. 2008-09 SY)	n/a
<b>14</b> Withdrawn under the public school choice	14 – Withdrawn to enroll in another school within the district under the provisions for public school choice in accordance with Title 1, part A, Section 1116. (Rev. 2006-07 SY) (Rev.2010-11 SY)	The student remains in the cohort if there is no subsequent enrollment.
<b>15</b> TEIS transition, not eligible for special education services	15 – TEIS transition, not eligible for special education services. Young child (assigned to Grade P3) transitioning from Tennessee Early Intervention Services withdrawn because child determined to be not eligible for special education services.	n/a
