Develop note taking system that includes important concepts, paraphrases, summaries, and identification of reference sources.

Organize information from text or technological sources using a graphic organizer.

Making Judgments

Determine the correct meaning/usage of multiple meaning words within context.

Use a variety of previously learned strategies to determine the meaning of unfamiliar words

Drawing Conclusions

Recognize reasonable predictions of future events within a given context.
